LB: Senior was the heart and sole of a young linebacking corps. Recorded his first 100-tackle season (107).



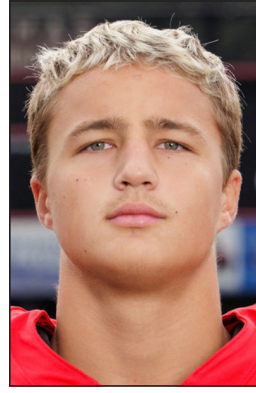
Jared Forner, Camas

DL: Senior 3A GSHL defensive MVP anchored a front-7 behind double-digit tackles-per-game average.



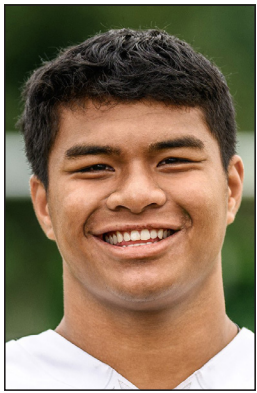
Beau Harlan, Camas

LB: Senior was constant noise-maker at outside backer. Racked up 18 tackles for loss and caused three fumbles.



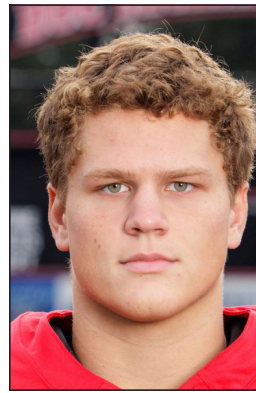
Elijah Franco, Washougal
